

Card Game Program

The Card Game Program consists of two major casino card games - (Baccarat and Blackjack), and one minor casino game (Casino war, Pontoon, or Three Card Poker – subject to class availability). It is tailored for students who want to enhance their demand potential as a Dealer in the casino industry. Our instructors will take students step-by-step through the mechanics of dealing in each game and also share with them their many years of dealing experience, an invaluable add-on.

Course Objective

This course is developed based on gaming industry skill competency standards. On completion of the course, students will have full game knowledge and application skills to interact with guests and be an effective card game dealers.

60 sessions of 3 hours per session - to complete within 5 months (20 weeks)
Time Schedule: 7pm to 10pm

Admission

- Secondary education or equivalent, to be assessed by the school.
- Aged 18 and above.

Assessment

Students must complete the course and take the appropriate assessment tests, pass them and be certified by the Examiners.
